

## Errata

Robin L. Snowberger, listed on page 84, is the daughter (not son) of Russell and Jean Snowberger.

The Cantrell ancestry of Sarah Ann Cantwell as given on pages 387–391 for her great-grandfather and earlier is in error. The following *ahnentafel* provides the corrections.

### Ahnentafel for Sarah Ann Cantwell

**1. Sarah Ann Cantwell (1869–1901).** She was born in October 1869, first child of Edward N. Cantwell (see entry 2) and Mary A. Heck (see entry 3). She married James Henry Davis. They were the parents of:

**6. Joseph Heck (about 1823-?).** He was born about 1823 in Kentucky, child of Joseph E. Heck (see entry 12) and Catherine Davis (see entry 13). He married first Elizabeth Schaffer about 1845, when he was about 22 years old. They were the parents of:

**12. Joseph E. Heck (1788-?).** He was born on 1 April 1788 in Maryland. He married Catherine Davis. They were the parents of:
